Petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.220 dated 20.08.2019 registered under Sections 420, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Sadar, Amritsar, District Amritsar.

On 25.09.2019, following order was passed by this Court:-

“After hearing learned counsel for the parties, this court is of the view that the petitioner should be directed to join investigation.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Adjourned to 20.11.2019.”

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from SI Amarnath, has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view thereof, order dated 25.09.2019 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
