Learned counsel for the petitioners states that this Court had allowed the claim of the petitioners vide order dated 04.09.2017 while deciding CWP No.27346 of 2016 and a direction was issued to the respondents to release all the pensionary benefits alongwith interest @ 9% per annum. Counsel for the petitioners states that as the order dated 04.09.2017 was not being complied by the respondents, the petitioners filed COCP No.1505 of 2018, wherein the respondents have filed affidavit that interest on delayed payment has been paid. COCP No.1505 of 2018 was disposed of by this Court on 11.12.2018 with liberty to the petitioners to raise their grievance before the respondents in case there is any discrepancy in the payment. Counsel for the petitioners states that keeping in view the liberty given by this Court vide order dated 11.12.2018, the petitioners have submitted to the respondents representation dated 04.05.2019 (Annexure P/7), which is still pending consideration with the

respondents and the petitioners will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioners, the respondents are directed to decide the representation dated 04.05.2019 (Annexure P/7) by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
