Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.309 dated 25.07.2019, under Section 174-A of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Sector 5, Panchkula.

This Court, while issuing notice of motion on 24.09.2019, passed the following order:-

“ Contends that the petitioner is ready to join the proceedings before the learned trial Court.

Notice of motion for 31.10.2019.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the learned trial Court within a period of one week. In case of his doing so, learned trial Court would admit him to interim bail till the next date of hearing on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to its satisfaction. ”

Contends that in terms of above order dated 24.09.2019, passed by this Court, petitioner has already joined the proceedings and regularly appearing before learned trial Court.

The aforesaid factual position is duly acknowledged by learned State Counsel, on instructions from H.C. Brijesh Kumar.

In view of above, interim order dated 24.09.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the present petition stands disposed off.

It is made clear that the petitioner shall fully co-operate with the learned trial Court and will not seek unnecessary adjournments.

The above observations may not be considered as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
