Petitioner herein seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents not to harass him at the behest of respondent No.4, who are senior to him and to restrain the respondents not to give threat of his termination.

Prima facie, I am not inclined to issue notice in the writ petition, while on the other hand, learned counsel appearing for respondents-UI submits that as per his instructions, the petitioner is in the process of being discharged from service on account of his having been placed under medical category.

In that view of the matter, writ petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to challenge his discharge from service as and when appropriate orders qua the same are

conveyed to him.
