Learned counsel for the petitioner states that after the retirement of the petitioner, a punishment was imposed upon the petitioner vide order dated 02.05.2016 (Annexure P-1) reducing his pension by 25% for a period of three years, which punishment has already come to an end in May, 2019 but still the petitioner is being paid only 75% of the pension keeping in view the order dated 02.05.2016 (Annexure P-1) passed by the respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that once the punishment is over w.e.f. 01.06.2019, petitioner is entitled for full pension, which is not being released by the respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner prays that a direction be issued to the respondents to restore the full pension of the petitioner after the expiry of punishment as imposed upon him in pursuance to the order dated 02.05.2016 (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that for the relief which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has served the respondents with a legal notice dated 17.06.2019 (Annexure P-2) which

is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said legal notice by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the legal notice dated 17.06.2019 (Annexure P-2), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 17.06.2019 (Annexure P-2), within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.
