ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 344 dated 06.09.2019, under Sections 186, 332, 353, 427 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Matlauda, District Panipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that he along with others had obstructed construction of the wall being carried out by the complainant under the supervision of the officials of the local administration and the police. He also contends that the petitioner is 75 years of age and there is no allegation that he actually used physical force against the complainant and others.

This Court, by the order dated 24.09.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-

interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Baljit Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 24.09.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
