The contempt petition under Section 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, has been filed pleading that the direction of this Court dated 6.3.2019 passed in CWP No. 18908 of 2018 have been wilfully disobeyed.

The petitioner filed a writ petition raising a grievance that family pension to which the petitioner is entitled to on the basis of last pay drawn including dearness allowance should be paid to the petitioner after the death of his wife. The respondents were directed to decide the legal notice dated 4.6.2018 within a period of three months from receipt of certified copy of the order.

On 25.9.2019 learned State counsel sought time for having instructions from the respondents.

Today, learned State counsel submits that needful shall be done within two months from today in case it is not already done and in case any amount is found due, the same would be disbursed within two months

thereafter.

In view of above, the contempt petition is disposed of.

However, the petitioner shall be at liberty to revive the contempt petition in case the needful is not done within the time period mentioned hereinabove.
