Short reply by way of affidavit filed in the Court today is taken on record.

Petitioner prays for bail pending trial in FIR No.415 dated 22.05.2019 registered under Section 18 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station Civil Lines, Karnal, District Karnal.

As per the case of the prosecution, petitioner was found in conscious possession of 1.503 kg opium which does not fall in commercial category.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Devinder Singh, submits that the petitioner is not involved in any other case.

The petitioner is in custody since 22.05.2019. Investigations are complete, final police report has been filed and charges have been framed.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the aforesaid facts as also conclusion of the trial is likely to take time, it is considered appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
