Petitioner prays for regular bail in FIR No. 777 dated 2.12.2017 registered under Sections 302, 328 & 34 IPC at Police Station Samalkha, District Panipat.

Learned counsel for the State on instructions from SI Ramesh Kumar has submitted that prosecution has already recorded deposition of 15 witnesses out of total 17 proposed to be examined. He submits that since trial is at advanced stage, therefore, it would not be proper to adjudicate upon the prayer for bail.

Keeping in view the stand taken by the State, present petition is disposed of by directing the learned Trial Court to make a sincere endeavour to conclude the trial positively within two months. Petitioner shall be at liberty to move an application for revival, if facts are otherwise.
