Petitioner is stated to be a farmer.

The short grievance raised in the petition is that he is being hounded by the police officials of Police Station, Guruharsahai, District Ferozepur and Police Station, Amir Khas, District Fazilka at the instance of respondent no.7, who is a Commission Agent and with whom the petitioner at one point of time had certain dealings.

Counsel would contend that respondent no.7 has approached the police authorities alleging that the present petitioner owes a sum of Rs.9 lakh and the police officials are acting as recovery agents.

In view of the above and without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the instant petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the same in terms of granting liberty to the petitioner to approach respondent no.2 i.e. Inspector General of Police, Ferozepur Range as regards his grievance/alleged harassment at the hands of respondents no.5 and 6.

In the eventuality of any such application being preferred, respondent no.2 would be obligated to have the matter examined and to thereafter take steps as he may deem fit and warranted in accordance with law.
