Petitioner seeks a Mandamus for directing the official respondents no.1 to 3 to take a decision on a representation dated 10.9.2019 (Annexure P-5) that is stated to have been submitted. Further grievance raised in the petition is that the petitioner is being harassed and hounded by the police authorities of Police Station, Katani Kalan, District Ludhiana.

Counsel has been heard at length.

Pleadings on record are utterly vague. Even though, there are averments that one Manjit Singh has filed a complaint but as of date no cognizance of the same has been taken.

The averments are not even sufficient for this Court to infer any imminent danger and threat to the life and liberty of the petitioner.

The respondent authorities are not duty bound to take action on each and every representation that may be submitted. No statutory provision in such regard has been cited by the counsel.

No interference in the matter is called for.

Petition is dismissed.
