HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner was senior to one Mangal Dass. The seniority position of the petitioner was 380, whereas, the seniority position of Mangal Dass was 535-C. Counsel for the petitioner argues that keeping in view the order passed by this Court in CWP-8780 of 2015(O&M), Mangal Dass has been given promotion with retrospective effect i.e. from the year 1985. Counsel for the petitioner further argues that another similarly situated person namely, Gurdeep Singh, who was also junior to the petitioner as his seniority position was 492, has already been granted benefit of promotion w.e.f. 1985 by the respondents vide order dated 26.4.2019 (Annexure P/9) as granted to Mangal Dass.

Counsel for the petitioner further argues that once the similarly situated persons have been granted promotion from the year 1985, the petitioner is also entitled for promotion from the said

date.

Counsel for the petitioner states that for the relief which has been sought in the present writ petition, the petitioner has served the respondents with a legal notice dated 10.06.2019 (Annexure P-15), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said legal notice.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner, the respondents are directed to decide the legal notice dated 10.06.2019 (Annexure P-15), by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
