Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in Criminal Appeal No.455 of 2017 (CNR No.HRHS03-007331-2017) dated 13.09.2017 in criminal complaint case No.441-II of 2014 dated 05.03.2014 under Section 138 of N.I. Act.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 25.09.2019: -

“...Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that after filing of the appeal, the petitioner was granted bail by the Additional Sessions Judge, however, he absented from the Court proceedings on 25.03.2019 and non-bailable warrants have been issued

against him. Learned counsel undertakes that the petitioner will surrender before the lower appellate Court within a period of 10 days from today...”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the order dated 25.09.2019, petitioner has again appeared before the Additional Sessions Judge and has been granted the concession of interim bail.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, has not disputed the factual position.

In view of the above, this petition is disposed of and the order dated 25.09.2019 passed by this Court is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions, on which the bail was initially granted by the Additional Sessions Judge, at the time of admission of appeal.
