The petitioners have filed present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in the event of their arrest in FIR No.113 dated 03.09.2019 under Sections 323, 406, 498-A and 506 IPC registered at Women Police Station, Karnal, District Karnal.

Pursuant to the previous order dated 26.09.2019, the parties are present in Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that during pendency of the present petition, the matter has been compromised between the parties. The petitioner No.1 and the complainant are staying together as husband and wife.

The aforesaid fact has not been disputed by learned counsel for the complainant.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the matter has been compromised between the parties and the petitioner No.1 and the complainant are staying together as husband and wife, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 26.09.2019, whereby arrest of the petitioners was stayed by this Court, is made absolute.

However, in case the petitioners are required in the case in any manner, a clear 15 days notice shall be served upon them.
