Petitioner herein seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to convert his case from the New Defined Contributory Pension Scheme and treat it under General Provident Fund (GPF) Scheme.

2. In the premise, he submitted various representations contained at Annexures P-4 to P-6 followed by legal notice dated 08.08.2019 (Annexure P-7) but the same have not been adverted to by the respondents till date. Hence, the writ petition.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On advance service of the petition, Ms. Ambika Bedi, AAG, Punjab appears and accepts notice on behalf of the State.

5. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

6. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to objectively consider the legal notice dated 08.08.2019 (Annexure P-7) and also by keeping in view the contentions stated in the present writ petition by treating it as a supplementary representation and pass a speaking order, in accordance with law.

7. Let the needful be done within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
