Learned counsel for the petitioners fairly admits that no details of the holidays on which the petitioners had worked, have been given in the writ petition so as to claim the benefit of salary for working on these holidays. In the absence of any details of the dates, which, were holidays and petitioners were on duty, no relief can be granted to the petitioners.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioners prays that petitioners be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to approach a Committee constituted by the Director State Transport, Haryana vide order dated 16.07.2019, which has been constituted to look into the grievance/claim of the drivers for the grant of the benefit of salary for working on holidays.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
