HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J.(ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the petitioner was appointed on part time basis on 15.09.1997 whereas, respondents No.4 and 5 were appointed in August/September, 2000 but still services of respondents No. 4 and 5 have been regularized by the respondents from a date, which is prior to the date on which the services of the petitioner have been regularized, which is illegal and arbitrary.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further argues that as services of respondents No.4 and 5, were regularized on 19.08.2014 whereas, the services of the petitioner were regularized on 21.04.2017, petitioner is also entitled for regularization of his service with effect from the date persons junior to him were regularized in service.

Learned counsel for the petitioner prays that a direction be issued to the respondents to regularize the service of the petitioner w.e.f. 19.08.2014 when the services of his junior namely Surender Kumar and Shamsher Singh-respondents No. 4 and 5, were regularized.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that for the relief which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has served

the respondents with a legal notice dated 16.05.2019 (Annexure P-4) which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said legal notice by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the legal notice dated 16.05.2019 (Annexure P-4), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 16.05.2019 (Annexure P-4), within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.
