Challenge in this petition is to the order dated 24.07.2019 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Civil Judge (Junior Division), Sohna, whereby evidence of plaintiff-petitioner (except cross-examination of PW-4) has been closed by order.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in the civil suit filed by plaintiff-petitioner for permanent injunction and mandatory injunction, written statement was filed on 19.09.2018. After framing of issues, plaintiff has examined five witnesses. As per application dated 11.08.2017 (Annexure P-4), diet money to summon/examine Sh.Sarjeet Singh son of Sohan Singh, a co-villager, had been deposited by the petitioner (plaintiff). Learned counsel prays that one effective opportunity may be provided to the plaintiff to examine the aforesaid witness.

In the given circumstances of the case, to impart complete justice to the parties, it would be appropriate, if adequate opportunity is provided to the plaintiff-petitioner to conclude his evidence.

Accordingly, the impugned order dated 24.07.2019 (Annexure P-

1) is set aside and the trial Court is directed to provide one effective opportunity to plaintiff-petitioner to examine the aforesaid witness namely Sarjeet Singh son of Sohan Singh, resident of village Bhondsi, Tehsil Sohna, District Gurugram in order to conclude his evidence.

Allowed accordingly.
