Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.72 dated 18.09.2018 under Sections 323, 365, 354-D, 506, 34 IPC registered at Police Station Ballabgarh, District Faridabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order dated 26.09.2019 of this Court, the petitioners have appeared before the trial Court and have been admitted on interim bail.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Nisha, submits that it is on the basis of an application filed under Section 319 Cr.P.C. the petitioners were summoned in the case.

Considering the fact that the petitioners have appeared before the trial Court and admitted on interim bail, the interim order dated 26.09.2019

is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall continue to appear before the trial Court unless exemption is not granted.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
