TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA.J (Oral)

Petitioner who is stated to be 21 years of age has filed the instant writ petition voicing an apprehension to her life and liberty at the hands of respondents no.4 and 5, who are none other than her own mother and brother respectively.

Counsel submits that the private respondents are forcing the petitioner to marry someone of their choice and upon such matrimonial alliance being resisted, petitioner has been threatened and even physically assaulted.

In the light of the grievance as afore-noticed and without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the same in terms of granting liberty to the petitioner to approach respondent no.3 i.e. S.H.O., Police Station, Civil Lines, Patiala confined to the aspect of danger and threat to her life.

In the eventuality of any such application being preferred, respondent no.3 would be obligated to look into the same and to thereafter take steps as he may deem fit and warranted in accordance with law.
