The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.0102 dated 01.09.2019 registered under Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act at Police Station Tappa Mandi, District Barnala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per the version of the prosecution, the recovery already stands effected and the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 04.10.2019, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Sukhdev Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 04.10.2019, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
