The present revision petition is filed against the order dated 30.05.2019 passed by the Additional District Judge, Sangrur (for short, the trial Court), vide which, a direction has been issued to give the compensation as per their respective shares and as per the revenue record.

While praying for setting aside the said order, learned counsel for the petitioners states that in the subsequent award, the competent authority had ordered that the compensation should be paid as per possession. However, learned counsel for the petitioners has not been able to point out any infirmity in the impugned order as to why the compensation should not be given as per the share of the land owners nor has brought any rules and regulations or case law that the compensation can be paid by any other method than as per the share.

In view of the same, no ground is made out to interfere with the order passed by the trial Court.

Dismissed accordingly.
