ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.127 dated 06.09.2019, under Sections 307, 323, 324, 148, 149 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, besides, Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Mahilpur, District Hoshiarpur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that although the petitioner is stated to have been armed with a 'kirpan', but he has not been attributed any injury. He also contends that the injuries, which are attributed to other accused, are also on the non-vital parts of the body of the injured.

This Court, by the order dated 26.09.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Kuldeep Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 26.09.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
