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TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J. (ORAL)

As per pleadings on record, petitioner apprehends danger to his life and liberty at the hands of private respondents No.5 to 9.

Counsel submits that inspite of an order passed by the civil Court in favour of the petitioner pertaining to a particular dera situated in village Mallukadrabad, Tehsil and District Kapurthala, the villagers/private respondents have demolished the same and are now threatening to even eliminate the petitioner.

Without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition and the assertions made by counsel during the course of hearing, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the instant writ petition in terms of granting liberty to the petitioner to approach respondent No.4 confined to the aspect of the threat that he fears to his life and liberty. In the eventuality of any such application being preferred, respondent No.4 would be obligated to look into the matter and to thereafter take steps as he may deem fit and warranted in accordance with law.
