Petitioner prays for grant of bail pending trial in a criminal case arising from FIR No.99 dated 12.5.2017 registered under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC at Police Station City Rajpura, District Patiala.

As per the case of the prosecution, three sale deeds have been executed, out of which one allegedly by Parkash Kaur, which is the result of impersonation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner is only a marginal witness being Lambardar of the village and he is not a beneficiary. He further submits that petitioner is in custody since 2.8.2019.

Investigations are complete. Police report as required under Section 173 Cr.P.C has already been filed. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Rajinder Singh has submitted that although petitioner is not a beneficiary but he has identified the vendor Parkash Kaur who was impersonated.

Case is triable by Magistrate. Trial of the case has started.
Conclusion of the trial is likely to take time.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the aforesaid facts, it is considered appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands allowed.
