Petitioner herein seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari to quash the charge dated 18.12.2009 (Annexure P-1), impugned order of punishment dated 12.08.2010 (Annexure P-8) followed by Appellate Authority's order dated 24.05.2018 (Annexure P-15).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner fairly submits that petitioner would be satisfied if the instant writ petition is to be disposed of with a direction to take a final decision on his revision petition dated 10.06.2018 (Annexure P-16) within a stipulated time frame.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On advance service of the petition, Mr. Anil Chawla,

respondents.

5. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Inspector General of Police, North West Sector, Head Quarter, Central Reserve Police Force, Hallo Majra, Chandigarh (U.T.) to decide his revision petition dated 10.06.2018 (Annexure P-16) after affording an opportunity of being heard to the petitioner and pass an appropriate order, in accordance with law.

7. Let the needful be done within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
