Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he has express instructions from the petitioners not to press the present petition on its merits and that they shall be satisfied if a direction is issued to the First Appellate Court to decide the petitioners' appeal filed by them against the judgment and decree of the Trial Court dated 25.10.2017 in a time bound manner.

The alternate prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners is found to be reasonable especially when the petitioners' appeal has been pending before the First Appellate Court for the last about 2 years and that a direction to decide the petitioners' appeal on its merits would not prejudice

any of the parties.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the First Appellate Court to decide the petitioners' appeal being CA No.483 of 14.12.2017 titled as “ Jaswinder Singh and others vs. Radhe Sham Malik and another”, within four months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

If the respondents are aggrieved by this order, they are at liberty to approach this Court by filing of an appropriate application.
