Mr. Karminder Singh, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent.

The present appeal has been directed against award dated 5.8.2019 passed by the Railway Claims Tribunal, Chandigarh Bench, Chandigarh (in short "the Tribunal"), whereby 25% of compensation awarded to major claimant namely Meenu was paid and the rest was ordered to be invested in Bank to be transferred in account of the claimant in 72 consecutive months at the rate of Rs. 4166.66p per month to claimant No.1 and Rs.2777/- along with proportionate interest per month to claimants No.2 and 3.

The precise question involved in this case is whether the Tribunal has rightly ordered for investing of compensation allowed to adult claimant(s) in fixed deposit or otherwise.

The controversy raised in the present appeal is squarely covered by judgment of this court in **Amarjeet Singh and another vs.Union of India through General Manager FAO No. 2037 of 2019 and connected cases decided on 4.9.2019.**

Disposed of in the same terms.
