Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail in FIR No.90 dated 11.07.2019 under Sections 399, 402 IPC, Section 411 IPC (added later on) and Section 25 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Sadar, Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per allegations in the FIR, on receiving a secret information that the petitioner along with some other persons are habitual of snatching and are planning to commit some heinous crime, a raid was conducted and the petitioner and others were arrested. It is further submitted that the petitioner is in custody since 11.07.2019; he is on bail in 01 FIR; the case is still at the stage of framing of charge and it will take long time in conclusion of the trial.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Lakhvir Singh, has not disputed the factual position.

Without commenting anything on merits of the case, considering the allegations in the FIR and custody of the petitioner, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing his bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

Petition is disposed of.
