Learned counsel for the petitioners at the very outset submits that some of the petitioners had approached this Court by way of filing CWP No. 25493 of 2014 and vide order dated 12.12.2014 said writ petition was disposed of with a direction to the petitioners to make a representation to the State Government and in case such a representation was filed, it was to be considered in accordance with law. The said order was passed in December 2014 but thereafter inspite of making many representations, no action has been taken on the same. Learned counsel also submits that similarly situated persons have been granted benefit as sought by the petitioners in the representations. Learned counsel also submits that the petitioners would be satisfied in case same directions are issued by this Court to take action on the pending representations in view of the directions already issued in case of similarly situated persons. Although the second petition is not maintainable but because of the reason that claim of the similarly situated persons have been considered. However, no action has been taken on the earlier representations inspite of specific direction issued by this Court in the earlier petition i.e. CWP No. 9576 of 1988.

Keeping in view the limited prayer, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents No. 1 and 3 to take action on pending representations in accordance with law preferably within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case presence of the petitioners or their representative is required, an opportunity of hearing be given to him and claim of the petitioners be redressed by the respondent-authority.
