Prayer is for quashing of FIR No.215, dated 08.07.2018, registered under Section 21 of the NDPS Act, (Section 29 of NDPS Act added later on), at Police Station Model Town, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is a licensed chemist and the petitioner has been nominated on the statement of co-accused, which is a weak evidence.

On a pointed question, learned counsel for the petitioner neither admits nor denies that the alleged narcotics were supplied by the petitioner or not?

The present petition involves disputed question of fact which cannot be adjudicated upon in a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

Hence, dismissed.
