This appeal has arisen from the judgment and decree dated 06.08.2018 vide which petition filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 filed by the respondent-husband for seeking a decree of divorce on the ground of cruelty, has been allowed.

During the pendency of this appeal, the matter was referred to Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this court in order to explore the possibility of a compromise. The parties have entered into a settlement, which was reduced into writing on 24.04.2019 as per which they have decided to part ways on payment of ₹5 Lacs by the respondent to the appellant. The respondent has paid ₹1 Lacs today in court by way of a cheque drawn in the name of the appellant and the remaining amount of ₹ 4 Lacs shall be paid as per the terms and conditions of the settlement dated

24.04.2019.

In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the appellant-wife who is present in court has prayed for withdrawal of the appeal.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

The appellant is still granted liberty to file an appropriate application for revival of the present appeal, in case, the respondent-husband resiles from terms and conditions of the agreement/settlement dated 24.04.2019.
