Averments made in the petition are grossly insufficient for this Court to infer any imminent danger to the life and liberty of the petitioners and who are stated to have entered into matrimony on 14.12.2018.

Instant petition is merely founded on an apprehension that brother of petitioner No.1 i.e. respondent No.6 is returning back from Dubai in the month of October, 2019 and since he has serious objections to the marriage, the petitioners would be harmed.

Averments even in such regard are utterly vague.

No intervention in the matter is called for.

Petition dismissed.
