[1]. By way of 3rd misc. petition, petitioner seeks interim bail for a period of four weeks in order to attend marriage of her niece namely Kanwaljit Kaur, whose marriage is going to be solemnized on 13.10.2019.

[2]. Vide order dated 27.09.2019, the factum of marriage of Kanwaljit Kaur was ordered to be ascertained by the State. On 07.10.2019, learned counsel for the petitioner was directed to inform the Court as to whether the petitioner is only the maternal uncle of Kanwaljit Kaur.

[3]. Today, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that petitioner is the only maternal uncle of Kanwaljit Kaur, however

this fact has been denied by learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Mewa Singh.

[4]. Learned State counsel further submitted that one more maternal uncle of Kanwaljit Kaur is also present in the house of the petitioner, who will attend the ceremonial activities in the marriage of Kanwaljit Kaur from maternal side. The petitioner is involved in total three cases including one under Gambling Act and one more under NDPS Act.

[5]. In view of divergence in respect of number of availability of maternal uncle of Kanwaljit Kaur in the house of the petitioner, no indulgence can be granted in this petition. This petition is accordingly dismissed.
