The petitioner has approached this Court seeking quashing of FIR No.12, dated 21.6.2019, registered at Police Station NRI, District Police Commissionerate, Jalandhar, under Sections 406, 498-A IPC (Annexure P-11).

Today, at the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw this petition at this stage with liberty to pursue the matter with the investigating agency wherein he may be permitted to apprise the investigating agency about the correct factual position which has been detailed in his representation dated 3.8.2019 (Annexure P-12).

In view of the aforesaid submission, the petition is dismissed as withdraw, at this stage. The investigating agency is however, directed to look into representation (Annexure P-12) and examine all the pleas raised therein and to take the same into account while filing any report under Section 173 Cr.P.C.

A copy of this order along with copy of representation Annexure P-12 be sent to Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar, so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
