This petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 1049 dated 03.10.2018, registered under Sections 307, 323, 324, 148, 149 of the IPC and Sections 25, 54, 59 of the Arms Act, 159 (Section 326 IPC added later on) at Police Station Chandnibagh, District Panipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits as per the allegations in the FIR, Mohit, Manjit, Vikas and Anit had given knife blow injuries to injured Amit and the only allegation against the petitioner is that when complainant Aman tried to save Amit, the petitioner took out a pistol and threatened the complainant that if he moves, the petitioner will shoot him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that statements of Amit, Surender and Rajender have already been recorded and the petitioner is in judicial custody for the last about one year and conclusion of the trial is likely to take a long time.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Balwan Singh and on the basis of the custody certificate filed today in Court, has not disputed the fact that petitioner is not attributed any injury to Amit and no fire arm was used in the incident.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, considering the fact that petitioner is in judicial custody for the last about one year; he is not attributed any injury to injured Amit and also in view of the fact that conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
