Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.36 dated 13.08.2018 under Sections 379-B, 411, 201 and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Majitha Road, District Police Commissionerate, Amritsar.

Notice of motion.

Mr.Ramandeep Sandhu, Sr.DAG, Punjab, has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested the petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the FIR in the present case has been

registered on the basis of complaint of Dr.Neeraj Sharma, wherein, it is

alleged that when she parked her Aactiva near Principal's office, two persons came and snatched her purse containing phone make Lenovo, ₹4000/- and other articles.

The petitioner was earlier arrested in case FIR No.67 dated 29.10.2018 under Section 379-B IPC, registered at Police Station Ajnala Road, wherein, he suffered disclosure statement that he is involved in the commission of crime, for which the present FIR has been registered.

The investigation in the case is complete.

Without commenting anything on the merits of case, in my opinion, no useful purpose will be served by detaining the petitioner during trial. The petition, as such, is accepted. Petitioner Amit Kumar @ Golu is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
