The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.53, dated 05.05.2017, under Sections 364, 307, 148, 149 IPC (offence under Section 326/324/323/201 IPC added later on) and Sections 25, 27 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Valtaha, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that the nephew of the complainant had been allegedly abducted by the petitioner along with other co-accused. He, however, contends that the nephew was released on the same day without any harm and it is a case of no injury. He also contends that the petitioner is in custody for over six months and is not involved in any other case.

Learned State counsel states that although charges have been framed but none of the 24 prosecution witnesses has been examined.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner is in custody for over six months, he is not involved in any other case and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take sometime, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
