This order of mine shall dispose of four Civil Writ Petitions
bearing No.27911, 27929, 27962 and 27978 of 2019 as the controversy
involved is the same.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the impugned order dated 24.05.2018 (Annexure P-5) rejecting the case of the petitioners for promotion from Primary/JBT Teacher to TGT Sanskrit, has erroneously been passed against their own order dated 27.04.2018 (Annexure P-4), whereas the persons having the same qualification, i.e., B.A., D.Ed. and Graduation have been provisionally promoted. He also submits that he has already served legal notices in this regard and petitioners would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the respondents to consider and decide the legal notices dated 16.07.2019 (Annexure P-7) within some specified time in terms of the order Annexure P-8 (colly).

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioners and without going into the merit of the case or commenting thereon, the present writ petition is disposed of with directions to the respondents to decide the legal notices dated 16.07.2019 (Annexure P-7) within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case the claim of the petitioners is to be accepted, the consequential benefits, if any, be released to them, in accordance with law and if the claim of the petitioners is not to be accepted, then a well reasoned and speaking order be passed and conveyed to the petitioners forthwith.

It is made clear that in case the legal notices is not decided within two months, there shall be costs of ₹ 25,000/- in each case to be paid to the petitioners.
