Petitioner raises a grievances that he is being prevented from running a lottery business within the district of Sangrur inspite of having necessary permission/authority/license under the provisions of the Lotteries (Regulations) Act,1998, Lotteries (Regulations) Rules, 2010 and Punjab State Regulation Rules, 2015.

Having heard counsel for the petitioner at length, instant writ petition is disposed of in terms of granting liberty to the petitioner to agitate his grievance before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur along with all supporting/relevant documents in support of his contention that he is duly authorized and he is a license holder to run the lottery business from various places in district Sangrur.

In the eventuality of any such representation being filed, respondent No.3 would be obligated to examine the same and to thereafter take steps as deemed fit and warranted in accordance with law.
