After hearing both sides, the revision petition is disposed off after setting aside the impugned order dated 28.08.2019 passed by the Ld. Civil Judge (Junior Division), Malerkotla, and by granting an opportunity to the petitioners-defendants to examine all their witnesses on one single effective date, which may be the date already fixed, and if, for some reason, it is not practicable for the Ld. Court below to do so, then, on two or more consecutive dates and subject to payment of costs of ₹3500/- in favour of the respondents.

2. Further, after completion of the defendants/petitioners' evidence, the Ld. Court below shall endeavour to dispose off the eviction petition as expeditiously as possible and preferably within a period of two months from the date of communication of this order.
