The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.46 dated 30.06.2019 registered under Sections 323, 506, 458, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Sandaur, District Sangrur.

The operative part of the order dated 30.09.2019, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Counsel for the petitioner submits that as per the allegations in the FIR, the injury attributed to the petitioner is on the left arm and wrist.

Notice of motion for 21.10.2019.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 30.09.2019, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Gurpal Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 30.09.2019, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
