Prayer is for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in FIR No.208 dated 14.08.2019, registered under Sections 66C, 66D, 66E of the Information Technology (Amendment) Act, 2008, at Police Station City, Moga, District Moga.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in fact, offences are bailable, however, on the wrong advice, application for pre-arrest bail was moved before the Court of Sessions which has been rejected. He submits that he may be permitted to withdraw this petition with liberty to apply for bail before the Court of learned Judicial Magistrate. He prays that learned Judicial Magistrate be requested to pass an order on merits without being influenced by the order dated 04.09.2019 passed by the Court of Sessions dismissing his application for pre-arrest bail.

Keeping in view the prayer made, the petition is disposed of with liberty aforesaid.
