The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.138 dated 17.08.2019 registered under Section 420 IPC at Police Station Koom Kalan, District Ludhiana.

The operative part of the order dated 30.09.2019, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Counsel for the petitioner submits that as per the allegations in the FIR, the complainant has entered into an agreement to sell with the petitioner and thereafter, the present FIR has been registered with the allegations that despite issuing a notice to return the double of the earnest money, the petitioner has failed to do so.

Notice of motion for 22.10.2019.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 30.09.2019, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI

Randhir Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 30.09.2019, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
