Petitioner seeks cancellation of bail granted to respondent No.2 in case FIR No.183 dated 17.11.2016 under Sections 307, 326, 325, 323, 341, 148 and 149 IPC registered at Police Station Samana, District Patiala vide order dated 24.05.2017 on the basis of alleged mis-user of concession of bail.

Petitioner has pointed out that respondent No.2 has mis-used the concession of bail by entering into the premises of the complainant-petitioner on 02.06.2019 after breaking open the lock of the gate. He and his other companions were duly armed with deadly weapons.

A complaint was made to the Police Station, Samana,

but no action was taken. Thereafter, a representation was made to Deputy Commissioner, Patiala, still no action was taken. A criminal petition bearing CRM-M No.30313 of 2019 titled 'Prabhjot Kaur and another vs State of Punjab and others' was filed and the same was disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala to look into the representation filed by the petitioners therein in respect of alleged incident dated 02.06.2019. The said representation has not been decided by the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala so far.

In my considered opinion, this petition is pre-mature at this stage.

Dismissed.
