**Main case**

By this common order, both the petitions bearing CRM-M-

42120-2019 and CRM-M-42153-2019 for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioners in FIR No.40 dated 23.02.2019 registered under Sections 406 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station City Rupnagar, shall stand disposed of.

As per case of the prosecution, Real Estate Development Company even after receipt of huge amount has failed to allot plot to the first informant-victim. Apart therefrom, for return of investment made by the first informant, cheques for an amount of ₹1,18,00,000/- were issued which have also been dishonoured. As per the allegations, first informant has been duped of the amount of ₹46,00,000/- paid in the year 2013.

In view thereof, this Court is not inclined to grant pre-arrest bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, both the petitions are dismissed.
