The contempt petition is filed pleading that the directions issued by this Court on 27.5.2019 in CWP No. 14226 of 2019 have not been complied with by the respondents.

The facts in brief are that the petitioner claimed step up of her pay equivalent to her junior. The writ petition was disposed of directing the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 29.3.2019. The needful was to be done within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

Learned counsel for the State has produced copy of order dated 19.11.2019, the same is taken on record and copy handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner. As per the said order, claim of the petitioner has been partly accepted.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from Mr. Harish Sharma, Senior Assistant in the office of Director, Public Instructions (Secondary Education), Punjab submits that arrears found due to the petitioner will be credited in her account within six weeks from today.

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty to avail the remedies in accordance with law against the order dated 19.11.2019.

In view of the above, the contempt petition is disposed of with liberty as prayed for.

In case the dues are not credited in the account of the petitioner within the time so specified, the petitioner shall be at liberty to revive the contempt petition.
