RAJIV SHARMA, J.

This appeal is instituted against the judgment dated 15.05.2017 rendered by the learned Single Judge in CWP no.10354 of 2017.

2. The case of the appellant before the learned Single Judge was that her husband was working as part time sweeper from 09.05.2007 to 09.04.2016 for two hours daily. She claimed compassionate financial assistance at par with persons working on ad hoc basis, daily wages and contract basis.

3. We have gone through the judgment dated 15.05.2017 of the learned Single Judge. The learned Single Judge has taken into consideration the policy dated 27.11.2014 whereby the compassionate financial assistance was extended to the persons appointed on ad hoc basis, daily wages and contract basis. The persons who have been appointed for two hours cannot be considered at par with the persons appointed on ad hoc basis, daily

wages and contract basis.

4. Accordingly, there is no merit in the appeal and the same is dismissed.

5. Since the main appeal itself has been dismissed, the application bearing CM-2395-LPA-2017 for adducing additional evidence is dismissed.
