AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner has approached this Court, praying for issuance of a writ of mandamus, directing respondent Nos.2 and 3 to take legal action on representation dated 24.07.2019 (Annexure P-2) submitted by him.

On a question being put by the Court as to whether the land on which heap of bricks has been kept adjacent to the wall of the petitioner belongs to him, the answer of the counsel is in negative. The photographs, which have been placed on record, indicate that there is quite a distance between the wall and the bricks, which have been stocked. Counsel for the petitioner has also conceded that there is some civil dispute pending between the relatives of the petitioner and respondent No.4.

If that be so, this Court, by way of present writ petition, cannot

be used as a tool to hoodwink a private person, who has not even used the land of the petitioner or encroached upon it.

Therefore, the present writ petition is dismissed with costs of ₹5,000/- to be deposited with the High Court Legal Services Authority.
