Petitioners are seeking indulgence of this Court for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to drop the departmental proceedings against the petitioners in accordance with their affidavit dated 05.03.2019 (Annexure P-1), wherein they have been considered to be the same persons, who in fact, appeared in HTET 2009 Examination. In this regard, had submitted representation dated 10.06.2019 (Annexure P-8), but there is no adherence thereto.

Learned counsel for petitioners submits that they will be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2-Directorate of Elementary Education, Haryana, to consider the representation dated 10.06.2019 (Annexure P-8) within a stipulated period.

Without going into the merits and demerits of the claim of the petitioner, I deem it appropriate to direct respondent No.2, to consider the representation dated 10.06.2019 (Annexure P-8), within a period of two

months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and shall pass a speaking order thereon after affording opportunity of hearing to petitioners, failing which, respondent No.2 shall be liable to pay costs of ₹25,000/- to petitioners.

This condition of imposing costs is only to prevent petitioners to run from pillar to post and avail remedy of contempt in case of non-compliance of directions issued by this Court.

The writ petition stands disposed of with the above direction.
